

Rector's Weekly Note



Looking Upward? The Rev. Mother Nina Bacas

Today (Thursday, May 9) is the Feast of the Ascension, the day Jesus ascended to glory at the right hand of God the Father. This day is the bookend to Christmas Day when Jesus became incarnate on Earth as a newborn baby. Luke tells us "Then he led them out as far as Bethany, and, lifting up his hands, he blessed them. While he was blessing them, he withdrew from them and was carried up into heaven."

This is an upward looking feast. During the heights of the pandemic in Virginia, my church had an outdoor Ascension Eucharist at Gravelly Point. Some of you may know this spot as a public boat launch at the end of the runway of Reagan National Airport. Every time a plane took off over our heads, we looked up! But should we be looking up? A poem by Steve Garnaas-Holmes has us see it another way:

The Ascension is not about
Jesus's body rising above the earth,
but about Jesus expanding beyond his body.
He didn't go up, he went out.
Into all of us.
The disciples stand there,
almost ready to believe
(they won't until Pentecost)
that the body is not there but here:
we are the body,

the body of the risen Christ. See that way. Act that way. Love that way.

And I will add: Dance that way, too, for you are a wondrous Body of Christ. Mother Nina+

Harrison Gomes USD's BiGI program

Harrison has been accepted into the University of San Diego's Black InGenius Initiative program:

"BiGI is committed to supporting students from 6th through 12th grade to successfully graduate from high school and enroll at the University of San Diego (USD) or any university they choose to attend. Starting this summer of 2024, sixty-eight current fifth graders (rising sixth graders) will embark on a journey that supports, encourages, and motivates the students through middle and high school and leads them to start their undergraduate education. USD will provide students with consistent academic support delivered by USD's School of Educational Leadership & Educational Sciences faculty and staff. As a commitment to the student, those who complete the seven years of participation in BiGI and are accepted to USD, the university will meet 100 percent of the federally demonstrated financial need of the student with a personalized financial assistance package."
